About: A juried exhibition open to artists working in all mediums. The theme for this exhibit is environmental art.

What is environmental art?

Examples:

- Artwork made from non-recyclable or “up-cycled” materials, or works created re-using materials in an unintended way.
- Any work that informs and interprets nature and its processes, or educates us about environmental problems
- Artworks created with sustainable materials/ methods
- Artworks that reflect the human relationship to the natural world.

Opening Reception: Saturday, September 10, 2011 from 4-8 pm.

Awards Ceremony: Saturday, September 10, 2011 at 6 pm.

Exhibition Dates: The exhibition and sale will be open and free to the public from Saturday, September 10, 2011 through Thursday, October 6, 2011.

Closing Reception: Thursday, October 6, 2011 from 5-8 pm (People’s choice vote will be revealed at this time).

Gallery Hours: Tuesday through Friday, 10-6, Saturday, 11-3.

Eligibility: The exhibition is open to artists 18 years or older. All work must be original work. Students must not present work for consideration if assisted in any way in arrangement or execution. Artists accepted for the exhibition will be asked for an artist bio for display purposes.

Awards:

Best of Show: \$500 2nd Place: \$250 People's Choice Award: \$100

Preparation of artwork: Size and weight of work is limited to that which can be moved by one person. Two-dimensional work is limited to 36" in width and should be finished for display; meaning framed or museum wrapped canvas (please, no staples or nails showing on the edges). Any work that is to be hung, including three-dimensional works, must be appropriately wired, and strong enough to support the piece. The label provided in the entry form must be filled out and affixed to the back of the hanging piece or the bottom of a standing piece.

Entries: An entry fee of \$25 for the first entry, \$12 for each additional entry. Up to 4 pieces can be entered in to the show. If sending digital files through email, files will be reviewed when payment is received, either through snail-mail or PayPal.

Schedule: Deadline for delivery of artwork for judging: Saturday, August 27, 2011.

Notice of Acceptance: by Wednesday, August 31, 2011.

Drop-off of Accepted Artwork: by Wednesday, September 7, 2011.

Pick up of Artwork not accepted: by Tuesday, September 6, 2011.

Pick up of Accepted Artwork after the show: Should be picked up by Thursday, October 13, 2011. Work shipped in will be shipped out between October 11-18.

Submission of Artwork:

- 1) Images of artwork can be sent via email to info@poprevolutiongallery.com, jpeg format, 180dpi, longest dimension sized at 10". Entry fees should be mailed to address below. Images should be titled as such: 'artist-last-name.title-of-work.jpg'.
- 2) Images of artwork can be burned onto CD and mailed along with entry fees to address below, jpeg format, 180dpi, longest dimension sized at 10". CD should be labeled with artist name, images should be titled as such: 'artist-last-name.title-of-work.jpg'. All digital files will be destroyed after opening reception.
- 3) Artwork can be delivered in person to Pop Revolution Gallery along with entry fee.
- 4) Artwork can be shipped. All shipping, insurance and transit costs are the responsibility of the artist. Work may be sent by the artist's desired carrier. A carrier of the gallery's choice will return shipped artwork to the artist, C.O.D. Artists with shipping accounts (i.e. UPS, FedEx) may send us a return slip. If your shipping address is different from your mailing address, please include alternate street address on the form. We do not ship to P.O. Boxes.

Entry Procedure Registration and Fees: The non-refundable entry fee is required. Fill out completely and mail to be received by August 27, 2011 the Registration Form below with payment for each entry. Entries submitted without payment or received after August 27, 2011 will not be eligible. Deliver your work, with labels attached, to Pop Revolution Gallery, 105 E. Main Street, Mason, OH 45040 according to the schedule above.
